Submission Requirements

- Artwork **must** be between 8.5x11 - 11x17. Any type of paper or poster board may be used as well as your choice of media.
- The following information on the back of this sheet **must** be completely filled out and taped to the back of each poster.
- Your artist can pick one of the two themes to base their drawing on this year:
“Every Second Counts, Plan 2 Ways Out” or “All Good Things Close To Home”
- There will be a 1st, 2nd, & 3rd place winner picked per grade per school. We also will pick three grand prize winners. The grand prize winner will receive a \$25.00 gift card.
- The winners will have their work displayed at the Oak Forest-Crestwood Area Chamber of Commerce Community Expo on October 14th held at Arbor Park Middle School from 9am to 1pm as well as being displayed throughout City Hall.
- Each student **must** do his or her own artwork.

Each student may enter only **one artwork** into the contest. All artwork must be dropped off at City Hall (15440 S. Central Avenue) in the drop box located in the front hall beginning on September 18th and must be dropped off **no later than 5:00 pm on Friday, September 29, 2017. Late arrivals will not be accepted.**
