



Maximum Tow Fee Schedule

For Oak Forest Police Department Authorized Tow Agencies

The following tow fee schedule is established under the authority of the City of Oak Forest Police Department as required by ordinance 112.67(B) effective December 1st, 2014. The listed rates are maximum rates allowable for police tows. Listed rates do not prohibit towing agencies from charging a lesser fee .

Police Tow Rates (towed means hoisted or carried from scene)

Auto, Van, Pick-Up Truck, Motorcycles	\$170
Any towed vehicle towing a trailer which requires a 2 nd tow	\$170
Any towed vehicle pulling a trailer that requires a 2 nd driver	\$60
Roll Over	from \$60
Clean Up	From \$35 plus \$15 per bag of oil dry
Mileage	\$90 for hook and \$3.00 per mile

Medium and Heavy Duty Tow Rates

Medium Duty Towing (8,000 to 40,000lbs)	\$250
Extended Service (after 2 hours)	\$150 per hour
Heavy Duty Towing (over 40,000lbs)	\$350
Extended Service (after 2 hours)	\$200 per hour
Heavy Duty Rotator / Crane – recovery work 2 hour min	\$450 per hour
Heavy Duty Truck over 50 Tons	\$350 per hour
Semi-Tractor and Driver Per Hour	\$175
Semi – Trailer – Flat Rate	\$175
Landoll Type Trailer – Flat rate	\$175
Fork Lift – Flat Rate – No Driver	\$275
Air Cushions – Flat Rate	\$2000
Fifth Wheel Dolly – Flat Rate	\$100

Road Service Rates

Vehicle Pull Out	\$95 for 1 st ½ hour and \$25 for every 15 minutes after / maximum fee of \$120
Stand -by Time >15 minutes	\$50 per hour billed by the hour
Service Calls (jump start, flat tire)	\$90

Storage Rates (starting on the 25th hour based on time on tow report)

Outside Storage	\$40
Inside Storage	\$75
Storage for Trucks / Trailers	\$75 / \$100 after 10 th day
After Hours Release Fee (Mon-Fri 8-5pm)	\$35
Illinois Title Search Fee	\$45

Daily storage rates will not be charged if business is unavailable to release vehicle after hours.
