AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 32.246 – CITIZENS ADVISORY COMMISSION

WHEREAS, the City of Oak Forest is an Illinois municipal corporation organized and operated under the laws of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oak Forest is a home rule municipality as defined by Article VII of the Illinois Constitution; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to revise the section of the Municipal Code as it relates to the composition and terms of office of the Citizens Advisory Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OAK FOREST, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION 1: The foregoing recitals are incorporated as substantive portions hereof as though fully set forth herein.

SECTION 2: That Section 32.246(A), *Membership*, of the Municipal Code concerning the membership of the Citizens Advisory Commission is deleted in its entirety and replaced in lieu thereof with the following:

(A) *The Oak Forest Citizens Advisory Commission shall be composed of nine commissioners and one ex-officio alderman to serve as liaison between the commissioners and the Council.*

SECTION 3 That Section 32.246(D)(1), *Membership*, of the Municipal Code concerning the length of appointment for commissioners is deleted in its entirety and replaced in lieu thereof with the following:

(D)(1) *Five of the commissioners shall serve for a two-year term, and*

SECTION 4 That Section 32.246(D)(2), *Membership*, of the Municipal Code concerning the length of appointment for commissioners is deleted in its entirety and replaced in lieu thereof with the following:

(D)(2) *Four of the commissioners shall serve for a one-year term.*

SECTION 5 If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION 6 All Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 7 This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication, as provided by law.


