

ORDINANCE NO. 2011-04-03400

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 73 – PARKING AT THE COMMUTER PARKING FACILITY

WHEREAS, the City of Oak Forest is an Illinois municipal corporation organized and operated under the laws of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oak Forest is a home rule municipality as defined by Article VII of the Illinois Constitution; and

WHEREAS, the Oak Forest Municipal Code regulates parking of vehicles at the commuter parking facility located at the Metra commuter train station; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City to amend the Municipal Code as it relates to permit parking, violations, and fees for violations for use of said parking facility.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OAK FOREST, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION 1: The foregoing recitals are incorporated as substantive portions hereof as though fully set forth herein.

SECTION 2: That Section 73.30, *Commuter Permit Parking*, shall be deleted in its entirety.

SECTION 3: That Section 73.31, *Violations; Use of Parking Spaces*, shall be deleted in its entirety.

SECTION 4: That Section 73.33 (A), *Fees*, shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced in lieu thereof with the following:


(A) Every person who uses the commuter parking facilities shall be permitted to park their vehicle for one (1) 24-hour period and shall pay a daily fee of \$1.25 as decided by the City Council in accordance with budgetary needs. No person shall use the commuter parking facilities without paying the daily commuter parking fee as established by the City Council.'

SECTION 5: All Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.


SECTION 6: If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 7: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect beginning July 1, 2011.
