AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 32.446 – ECONOMIC ADVISORY COUNCIL  
COMPOSITION; TERMS OF OFFICE

WHEREAS, the City of Oak Forest is an Illinois municipal corporation organized and operated under the laws of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oak Forest is a home rule municipality as defined by Article VII of the Illinois Constitution; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to revise the section of the Municipal Code as it relates to the composition of the Economic Advisory Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OAK FOREST, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** The foregoing recitals are incorporated as substantive portions hereof as though fully set forth herein.

**SECTION 2** That Section 32.446(A), *Membership*, of the Municipal Code concerning the membership of the Citizens Advisory Commission is deleted in its entirety and replaced in lieu thereof with the following:

(A) *The membership of the EAC shall consist of seven persons, appointed by the Mayor, subject to the advice and consent of the City Council.*

**SECTION 3** That Section 32.446(C), *Membership*, of the Municipal Code concerning the length of membership of the Economic Advisory Council is deleted in its entirety and replaced in lieu thereof with the following:

(C) The EAC's membership shall serve rotating terms of three years, with initial membership limited to the following terms of office:

- (1) *Four members shall serve for an initial term of two years; and*
- (2) *Three members shall serve for an initial term of three years.*


**SECTION 4** If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this ordinance.

**SECTION 5** All Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**SECTION 6** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication, as provided by law.


