**LETTER OF APPRECIATION**

Sgt. Lopez advised me of outstanding police work done by you in reference to the apprehension of a domestic battery suspect on January 24, 2012 in reference to report 2012-1955. According to Sgt. Lopez:

On 01/23/2012, our department was advised via an ISPERN dispatch that they were looking for a subject, Allen W. Adcock, that was involved in a Domestic Battery/Home Invasion in Lombard IL. Said dispatch also mentioned that the subject may be heading to an address in Oak Forest @ 4841 W. 151<sup>ST</sup> and was driving a white colored Ford Explorer bearing Indiana registration.

On 01/24/2012, said information was given to the third shift Officers at their roll call.

As soon as Officer Reid was dismissed from roll call, he began making periodic checks for said suspect and vehicle. At approximately 1953 hrs, Ofc. Reid observed the suspect's vehicle at the end of the driveway. Officer Reid subsequently parked his patrol unit on Laporte Ave. and conducted surveillance while he radioed dispatch.


As dispatch was being advised, the suspect's vehicle backed out of the driveway and proceeded to the Marathon gas station. Ofc. Reid subsequently activated emergency equipment and exited his vehicle. Ofc. Reid was able to confirm the suspect's identity via a driver's license photo image and placed the subject under arrest.

The subject was later picked up by a Lombard Officer who advised Ofc. Reid that said suspect had kicked in the door to his ex-girlfriend's residence and battered her. Said Officer also mentioned that the victim was in the hospital and pregnant.

Because of Ofc. Reid's dedication and actions, a felon was apprehended. Ofc. Reid has added to the public confidence in the agency by maintaining his professionalism, dedication, and expertise.
