## Apply For Home Energy Assistance Programs

Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) | ComEd Residential Special Hardship Fund | Peoples Gas Share the Warmth

### Documents needed to apply:

- Proof of current 30-day gross income from all household members
- Proof of Social Security numbers of all household members (*Hard-copy of Social Security cards, printout from the Social Security Administration or any other form of government-issued identification that shows both name and Social Security number.*)
- If a member of your household receives TANF, you must bring their Medical Eligibility Card
- Copy of most recent heat and electric bills if you pay for your home energy directly
- Applicants that have their utilities included in the rent **must** bring proof of rental agreement stating monthly rental amount, that utilities are included, and landlord contact information (*Rent costs must be greater than 30% of current household 30-day gross income.*)
