Car batteries, Appliances, Tubed Computer Monitors (CRT), and Toner Cartridges

### PRESCRIPTION REQUIREMENTS:

PRESCRIPTION DRUGS OR NON-PRESCRIBED PHARMACEUTICALS CAN BE LEFT IN THEIR CONTAINERS.

**NO HYPODERMIC NEEDLES OR LIQUID MEDICINES**
